DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (Oral)

Petitioner is the defendant before the learned Trial Court.
Her evidence had been closed, vide impugned order dated 30.11.2022
(Annexure P-8) against which present revision is filed.

2. It is contended by the counsel that the petitioner requires one
opportunity to conclude her evidence. It is admitted by the petitioner that
she had already availed numerous opportunities to conclude her evidence
but failed to conclude the same as observed by the Trial Court.

3. Heard.

4. In the interest of justice, one opportunity is provided to the
petitioner to lead her evidence to be produced on her responsibility,
subject to ₹25,000/- as costs to be paid to the opposite party by way of a
demand draft. Impugned order is set aside. Learned trial court shall fix a
date for evidence of the petitioner.

5. Revision is disposed of accordingly.

6. This order has been passed without serving notice to the respondents in order to avoid any delay in the matter. However, if the respondents are aggrieved by this order, they can approach this Court.
