This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct proper, fair, impartial and expeditious investigation in a case bearing FIR No.013 dated 20.01.2018 under Sections 307/323/34 of the IPC and under Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and to present the challan before the Illaqa Magistrate and to take appropriate action against accused/respondents No.4 to 7 in accordance with the provisions of law.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 26.02.2019. Even today, none has put in appearance on his behalf.

Learned Senior Counsel for respondents No.4 to 7 states that the FIR No.13 dated 20.01.2018 under Sections 307/323/34 of IPC and

Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) which is the subject matter of the present petition has been quashed on the basis of compromise by this Court vide judgment/order dated 24.07.2020 passed in CRM-M-14165-2020 titled as 'Amandeep Singh and others versus State of Punjab and another'.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.

However, if the cause of action still survives, petitioner is at liberty to file an appropriate application for revival of the petition.
