Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the OMR sheet of the petitioner has not been correctly checked as, as per the answer key, keeping in view the questions attempted by the petitioner, the petitioner is entitled for 46 marks whereas, the petitioner has been shown to have obtained 44 marks, which is incorrect. Further prayer of the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been granted 05 marks as none of the family member of the petitioner is in Government job and the benefit of the said marks has also not been extended to the petitioner due to which, the petitioner has not been able to make grade in respect of the post for which he was competing keeping in view the number of posts available by way of direct recruitment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P/7), which is

still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P/7) addressed to the Chairman in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her representation dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P/7), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 23.11.2022 (Annexure P/7) by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
