Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to consider the suspension period of the petitioner from 28.06.2019 to 14.11.2019 as duty period and release all benefits including pay etc. for the aforesaid period.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the statutory appeal dated 15.03.2022 (P-7) is considered and decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the appellate authority to consider and decide the aforesaid statutory appeal dated 15.03.2022 (P-7) of the petitioner on or before 31.03.2022 by passing reasoned order as per law if there is no legal impediment.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
