The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to stay the lifting of waste yield (Jhar Foos) by the private respondents as tender for the same has been allotted to the petitioner vide works order dated 13.05.2022.

The clandestine removal of the waste yield (Jhar Foos) is alleged to be done by private respondents. The dispute is private and relates to the inter se private rights and compensation, if any, to which the petitioner may be entitled. The same would thus not fall within the ambit of power of judicial review.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
