VIKAS BAHL, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 31 dated 12.09.2006 under Sections 307, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Model Town, Distict Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

The case has been called on three occasions and none has appeared on behalf of the parties. From the same, it is apparent that the compromise has not crystallized.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, there were three accused out of whom two accused have already been convicted and sentenced to undergo 7 years of rigorous imprisonment.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case the compromise is still effectual and the parties are ready to get their statements recorded.

Is is made clear that in the case said fresh petition is filed, the same would be considered independently on its merits.
