On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed :

“The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 and 227 of the constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(b) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act is seeking extension of parole for a period of 8 week on medical grounds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that petitioner has been convicted and sentenced to rigorous imprisonment of life in an FIR under Section 302, 341, 506 and 34 IPC. The petitioner at present is on parole till 18.12.2022. The petitioner has met with an accident in which petitioner has suffered from fracture on his leg. Medical record has been enclosed as Annexures P1 and P2. The petitioner has been granted parole on 3-4 earlier occasions and every time he has surrendered within time.

Notice of motion returnable for 16.12.2022.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Dimple Jain,

AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file status report.”

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Inspector Rajbir Singh submits that the petitioner has suffered from fracture on his leg and he has undergone treatment from PGI. He has further confirmed that the petitioner is on bed.

In view of averments made by the petitioner and confirmed by learned State counsel, the period of parole granted to the petitioner is extended for 06 weeks. The petitioner on the expiry of 06 weeks from 18.12.2022 shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on or before 30.01.2023.
