1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/5, in CWP-21530-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/5 reveals that CWP-21530-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide representation dated 31.08.2022 besides any supplementary representation and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case on decision, the petitioner was found entitled to any pecuniary benefits, to release the same to the petitioner within two months thereafter.

3. Although notice has not been issued in this case, yet, learned AAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 09.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation

to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 09.12.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
