The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.30 dated 30.04.2022 registered under Sections 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Airport, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-3) registered in pursuance to the order dated 22.12.2021 passed by the trial Court in Complaint Case No.NACT/6006/2018 dated 01/02.11.2018 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the above-said complainant has already been withdrawn by the complainant and vide order dated 14.05.2022 passed by the trial Court the petitioner has been discharged. It is also submitted that in view of the complaint having been withdrawn, continuance of the proceedings under Section 174-A of the IPC would not be in the interest of justice.

In view of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the above-said FIR No.30

dated 30.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are ordered to be quashed.
