SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The petitioner is a 5th semester student of Five Years Integrated Law Course. In the current semester she left for the United Kingdom in July 2022, allegedly, to nurse her aunt who was having complications during advanced stage of pregnancy. She was due to return on 31.08.2022 but could not do so as mother-in-law of her aunt was not issued a Visa. As a result, the petitioner stayed on and returned only on 07.11.2022. Allegedly, she has attended classes w.e.f. 08.11.2022 but roll number for the forthcoming semester examination was refused in the afternoon on 08.12.2022. Thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the extended stay of the petitioner in the United Kingdom was on account of reasons beyond her control. Thus, she should be permitted to take the semester examination.

Assuming that the submission is correct, the reason for refusal to issue the roll number is not forthcoming from the record. Thus, alleged illegality can not be examined. As a result, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
