Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.165 dated 11.12.2018 under Section 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983 and Section 13 of the Travel Professional Regulation Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Jalandhar Cantt. Jalandhar.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 28.11.2019, pursuant thereto reply dated 05.04.2022 by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police-V, Contonment, Jalandhar has been filed.

Learned State counsel makes a reference to paras 7 and 8 of the preliminary submission to contend that the petitioner was arrested on 13.04.2021 and after completion of investigation, final report was presented on 13.05.2021 and charges have been framed against the petitioner on 15.11.2021; the trial is going on the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 13.12.2022.

In view of the aforesaid, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in

the present case.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of alternate remedy, available to him, in accordance with law.
