ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is working as a Senior Manager with the respondent on a salary of ₹58,106/- has been fastened with a liability of ₹6,89,431/- + 8% interest on account of issuance of chargesheets for delivery of less assured gain vide order dated 03.11.2021 (Annexure P-1). The petitioner has preferred the statutory appeal along with an additional submission (Annexure P-2 & P-3) thereagainst under Rule 20 of the Haryana State Supply and Marketing Cooperative Service (Common Cadre) Rules, 1988 with respondent No.1 on 08.12.2021 and 25.11.2022 respectively which has not been decided till date. He submits that in a similar petition bearing CWP-26467-2019 titled as **Kulwinder Singh vs. Board of Directors, The Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Ltd. and others**, wherein the petitioner was also a Salesman with Markfed and recovery of ₹1,55,29,777/- had been directed against him, the Coordinate Bench had directed the revisional authority to decide the petition within a period of three months. It was also

directed that further recovery also be stayed subject to the final order that may be passed by the revisional authority.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of without issuing notice to the respondents with a direction to the appellate authority (respondent No.1) to consider and decide the appeal (Annexure P-2) and additional submission (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the appellate authority.
