Affidavit in compliance of the last order has been filed by the
appellant. It is mentioned therein that in pursuance of the order of the
Learned Single Judge in CWP No. 10407 of 2019 and the interim order
passed on 23.04.2019, in the said case, respondent's normalized score is
112.91. As per the affidavit, cut-off score in the final merit list is 117.83 in
the unreserved category and, therefore, he is not entitled for appointment to
the post of Constable.

Counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that keeping in view the above facts, the litigation has been rendered unfruitful as the writ petitioner has not met the necessary cut off score.

Keeping in view the above, the instant appeal is disposed of having rendered infructuous.
