The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for taking action in FIR No.896 dated 25.12.2016 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 471, 468 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad and to conduct fair and impartial investigation into the same.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present case, the cancellation report has already been prepared and the same has been approved by the Commissioner of Police, EOW Cell, Faridabad and the same is likely to be submitted before the trial Court. It is further submitted that in view of judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case titled ***Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others***, reported as ***2008 (2) SCC 409*** and in ***M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another***, ***Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011***, decided on 20.03.2020,

the present petition before the High Court is not maintainable.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said facts.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances and also in view of the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Sakiri Vasu's case (supra)** and in **M. Subramaniam's case (supra)**, the present petition is dismissed. The liberty is however, granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
