It is submitted that the petitioners are *gair marusi* on land belonging to the Wakf Board. They are being dis-possessed therefrom forcibly with police help without any eviction order having been passed against them. Thus, representation diarized on 9.12.2022 has been submitted, yet, no action has been taken, thereupon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation (Annexure P-7) received on 9.12.2022 by passing a speaking order within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Till the representation is decided, the petitioners shall not be dis-possessed.
