[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CWP-18573-2022.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-18573-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and take a decision on the Justice Demand Notice as well as legal notice, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case after the decision, the petitioner was found entitled to any benefit, to release the same to him, within six weeks thereafter, as per law.

[3] At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 22.12.2022, rejecting the claim as contained in Justice Demand Notice as well as legal notice served by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that he does not press the

instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge

order dated 22.12.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
