JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.5 to 17.

2. The grievance of the petitioner in the present case is that she was being repeatedly threatened by the private respondents and she had even filed complaint to the learned Magistrate also in this regard and an application was also filed to Station House Officer, City Police Station, Hoshiarpur by way of a registered post on 11.11.2019 but no action was taken by the police pertaining to the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her mother who were under threat.

3. This Court had issued notice of motion on 02.12.2019 and an affidavit has been filed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur in

this regard. Learned State counsel while referring paragraph 8 of the affidavit has submitted that the petitioner had come to the Police Station, City Hoshiarpur on 07.12.2019 and she had given her statement with regard to her MLR and on the basis of her statement, an FIR No.210, dated 07.12.2019, under Sections 323, 452, 342, 354-B, 149, 379 and 506 IPC, 1860 was registered at Police Station City, Hoshiarpur against respondents No.5 to 17 and the police is conducting investigation in the present case. It is further submitted in paragraph 9 of the affidavit that the petitioner was offered police protection but she stated that since she was not feeling well and she was not residing in her house and as such, she does not require police protection at this time and in case she needs police protection then she will inform the Police Station City, Hoshiarpur and in this regard DDR No.33, dated 07.12.2019 was recorded in the Police Station City, Hoshiarpur.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the affidavit filed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and also the fact that as of now the petitioner is not apprehending any threat from the private respondents, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

5. Mr. Jasraj Singh, Advocate appearing on behalf of the private respondents No.5 to 17 has stated that the private respondents have never posed any threat to the petitioner and in future also they will not pose any threat to the petitioner.

6. In view of the aforesaid position, since the petitioner has prayed for withdrawal of the present petition, the same is dismissed as withdrawn.
