Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.154 dated 17.09.2022, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is not even a close relative of the in-laws of the complainant. He has submitted that the petitioner has been implicated in this case only in order to harass her.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and at the outset submits that the matter is under investigation and the grievance of the petitioner would be taken into consideration at the time of investigating the case.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to avail alternative remedy as available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. The State would conclude the the investigation keeping in view the grievance raised by the petitioner.
