Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.62 dated 6.11.2019 registered under Sections 498-A, 506, 376, 377, 34 IPC at Police Station, WPS, Rewari.

By virtue of the order dated 27.11.2019 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned senior counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 27.11.2019, the petitioners have joined the investigation. It is further submitted that the parties were referred to the Mediation Centre, Rewari, however, the matter could not be settled amicably. Report of the Mediator dated 3.1.2022 has also been placed on record affirming the fact that the matter could not be settled.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also affirmed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners. He further submits that some of the dowry articles are yet to be recovered.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the above submissions and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 27.11.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
