The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to the official respondent to give advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in writing in case the petitioner is to be called in any inquiry/investigation being conducted by respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State .

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 – The Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 02.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such

representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
