The petitioner herein has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct fair investigation in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.421 dated 16.11.2017 registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 302 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (wherein the offences under Sections 325 and 307 IPC are stated to have been added later-on).

2. However, despite the instant petition having been taken up twice during the day, none has appeared in the Court to represent the petitioner.

3. Reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana, is already available on the file and the same is taken on the record.

4. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Govind Parshad from the afore-said Police Station, apprises the Court that respondent No.4-accused has already been arrested in connection with the above-said case and the Challan has been presented in the Court and the trial has also commenced.

5. In view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, it is explicit that the cause of action does not survive any more in favour of the petitioner to pursue the present petition further and thus, this petition has become infructuous.

6. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands disposed of accordingly.
