On an application filed by the private respondents for transfer of land to another outlet, their share was ordered to be transferred by the Deputy Collector vide his order dated 28.01.2022. The share of the petitioner measuring about 04 acres has not been ordered to be transferred. Allegedly, at the time of implementation, the land of the petitioner is also sought to be transferred to the said outlet whereafter an appeal was filed which was dismissed upholding the order of the Deputy Collector. Further, appeal filed before the Superintending Canal Officer was also rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while implementing the order of the Deputy Collector, the land of the petitioner is to be excluded and an observation in this regard may be made while disposing of the writ petition.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with the observation that the order of the Deputy Collector shall be implemented in accordance with the direction contained therein.
