Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to provide the correct base salary i.e., 10,900 + 72PP as on 01.01.1996 in pay scale of Rs.6,500-200-10,500 w.e.f. 01.01.1996, and to provide all the benefits.

2. *Qua* his grievance, petitioner also submitted a representation dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-9), but the same has not been adverted by respondents till date. Hence the petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-9) by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation, as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the pending representation dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner, and pass an administrative order giving reasons thereof, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 2 months from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
