This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the arrears on account of increments etc. pursuant to order dated 20.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) wherein it has been ordered that the petitioners sent back to PAP will be entitled to seniority, promotion and all other benefits, however, though they have been granted seniority, but financial benefits have not been paid to them.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would contend that in this regard, the petitioners have already served representations dated 06.11.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) upon the respondents, but till date, no decision has been taken thereon. He would submit that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case their representations are decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representations dated 06.11.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) of the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
