Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to release the due amount qua the works mentioned in Work Order Nos.52 and 47 dated 08.08.2020 (Annexures P-2 and P-5) .

Briefly, the facts of the present writ petition are that respondent No.2-Municipal Council, Amloh issued a notice inviting E-Tender No.E.O. Amloh/2020-2021 (2020-DLG-50756). The petitioner bid for the purpose of civil works mentioned at Serial Nos.14 and 20 and he was granted Work Order Nos.52 and 47 dated 08.08.2020 for the above mentioned works. The

petitioner entered into an agreement with respondent No.2 to commence the work and he successfully completed it within the stipulated timeframe of three months. Thereafter, the petitioner vide email dated 15.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) requested respondent No.2 for releasing the balance outstanding payment but it resulted in no effect.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the present petition be treated as his representation and respondent no.2 is directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, A.A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab, would be deemed to be on the panel of all statutory Boards and Corporations of the State of Punjab by virtue of his appointment, is requested to accept notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2. They have no objection to the above prayer being allowed.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case and with the consent of the parties, the present civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Municipal Council, Amloh, Local Government, Punjab, to treat the present writ petition as a representation and to pass a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

If the entitlement of the petitioner is established upon

consideration of the claim and verification of the record, then the payment
be released to him within a further period of three months thereafter.

Petition is disposed of.
