[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 14.09.2022, in CWP-3233-2022.

[2] A perusal of Annexure P-1, reveals that CWP-3233-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to release retiral benefits to the petitioner along with interest.

[3] Although notice has not been issued in this case yet, learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of order dated 15.12.2022, sanctioning an amount of Rs.17,06,275/- on account of gratuity, leave encashment and interest. Learned counsel further states that the aforementioned amount would be released to the petitioner within two weeks from today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof state that while he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to move a representation before the respondent for outstanding payment if any on reconciliation.

[4] The same is not opposed to by the learned counsel for the respondent.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
