[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 19.07.2022, in CWP-26606-2021.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-26606-2021, was disposed of in terms of the decision in CWP-25369-2018, in case titled as Shaminder Singh vs. The Punjab Agro Industries Corporation and another, decided on 30.09.2019, wherein challenge was to the initiation of disciplinary proceedings beyond retirement/after retirement, in the absence of a Rule to the said effect. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has produced copy of order dated 19.12.2022, sanctioning payment of Rs.14,11,236/- and states that the payment would be released to the petitioner by 31.12.2022. Order of sanction is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to

represent to the respondent for release of additional payment as per

entitlement, if any found pending on reconciliation.

[3] The same is not objected to by the learned counsel for the respondent.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for while directing the respondent to release the sanctioned amount to the petitioner on or before 31.12.2022.
