The petitioner has filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the respondent No.5 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner and his family by calling him to the police station and further directing the respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 30.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) to respondents No.4-Station House Officer, Samana and he shall be satisfied in case an appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into his representation dated 30.11.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present

petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible.

Disposed of, accordingly.
