Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint Case No.11 dated 13.09.2017/21.01.2019 titled as 'Chetan Singh Vs. Avtar Singh etc.', registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 IPC, at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, which is pending before the JMJC, Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala, in the order dated 06.12.2022, has observed that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, however, directed him to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days and seek regular bail. In such circumstances, the Additional Sessions Judge should have granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case that the petitioner is summoned in the aforesaid complaint filed by respondent No.2 and he is to put in appearance before the trial Court, this petition is disposed of with a direction that if the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today, he will be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
