Present petition is under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 88 dated 27.09.2019, registered under Sections 406-498-A IPC, 1860 at Police Station Women Cell Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

On 29.11.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 6.3.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

During the course of proceedings, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per the report, an amicable settlement has been effected between the parties. The settlement/agreement has been received in the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of

interim directions, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh, learned State counsel has not assailed the aforesaid factual aspects and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. Furthermore, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties through mediation.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 29.11.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
