The petitioners through instant petition are seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 5 not to harass the petitioners and not to call the petitioners to the police station without issuance of notice as required under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and 41-A Cr.P.C. The petitioners are further seeking direction to official respondents not to humiliate/harass the petitioner.

Inter alia contends that son of the petitioners was married to Ramandeep Kaur on 11.05.2008 and they are blessed with three children. The relations between son and daughter in law of the petitioners are not cordial. The petitioners have already disowned their son. The police party is raiding premises of the petitioners and they apprehend that they may be implicated in a false case.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures that

jurisdictional authorities would not take any coercive step against the petitioners without following the procedure prescribed by law.

This Court in view of the statement of learned State counsel is sanguine of the fact that police authorities would not take law in their hand and proceed against petitioners, if necessary after compliance of mandate of Section 160 and 41-A of Cr.P.C. No further order is warranted.
