Counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that he confines his prayer to the challenge to the order dated 31.03.2014 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner was declared to be 'proclaimed person'. He submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court. Apart from that, he relies upon the compromise effected between the parties (Annexure P-4).
