HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intended to apply for the post of TGT English but inadvertently while applying, the petitioner applied for the post of TGT Social Science though, the petitioner concedes that she was not eligible for the said post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already been selected for the post for which she was not eligible but now, she is not being allowed to join on the ground that the petitioner is ineligible to perform the duties of TGT Social Science.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that immediately after applying for the post, the petitioner realize the inadvertent mistake and made a representation to the respondents to correct the same and be considered for the post of TGT English instead of TGT Social

Science.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by filing a representation dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
