The present writ petition had been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking quashing of the communication dated 09.10.2018 (Annexure P-19) and 23.10.2018 (Annexure P-20) issued by the State Registrar, Firms and Societies Haryana as well as the communication dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-21) issued by respondent No.4 and consequential communication dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure P-22) whereby membership of respondent No.5-society-Jatt Dharamshala had been opened on payment of a meager sum of Rs. 1100/- instead of the requirement of construction of a room and further for issuance of writ of Mandamus to conduct fair and transparent election to the Governing Body/Executive body of the respondent No.5 society i.e. Jat Dharamshala.

Mr. Vivek Chauhan, AAG, Haryana on instructions from

Industrial Extension Officer Kishore Kumar has apprised the Court that election to the Governing Body/Managing Committee of respondent No.5-Society-Jat Sabha, Dharamshala has already been held in April, 2022.

In view of the aforesaid statement, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed accordingly.
