Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner for a period of 8 weeks in FIR No. 231 dated 10.10.2022 under Sections 379B, 511, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Samana, Tehsil and District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that present petition has been filed for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner for enabling him to appear in the examinations, as the petitioner is a student of B.A. 2nd Year in Khalsa College Patiala and examination of 3rd Semester of B.A. 2nd Year are scheduled to take place from 14.12.2022 to 23.01.2023, in which petitioner has to appear till 17.01.2023. In support of his arguments, he has drawn attention of this Court to the Admit Card (Annexure P-2) and Date-Sheet (Annexure P-3). Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that after completion of examination, petitioner shall surrender before the Authorities forthwith.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ishneet Kaur, Assistant AG Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab and on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh, states that instead the examination of the petitioner are scheduled from 14.12.2022 to 17.01.2023. She further submits that she has no objection if the petitioner is allowed to appear in the aforesaid examination.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to released on interim bail upto 17.01.2023 subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 18.01.2023 after completion of the examination.
