Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 09.12.2021 (P-24) and hold her entitled for grant of benefits and arrears upto 04 (four) steps of UGC Scale.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 01.11.2022 (P-27) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Department of Medical Education and Research, Punjab, to decide the aforesaid legal notice by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of 03 (three) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
