Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes a fact that the averment made in paragraph 17 of the writ petition that against the impugned order, there is no remedy of appeal available to the petitioner, is incorrect and the said averment may be treated to have inadvertently.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will file an appeal against the impugned order dated 13.12.2022 (Annexure P-24) before the Appellate Authority within a period of 10 days from today and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty to file the appeal.
