Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that implementation of transfer policy of the Guest Teachers is causing prejudice to the petitioners as the petitioners were initially transferred in the month of September and now they are again dislodged, which is totally arbitrary and illegal. Further grievance of the petitioners is that even otherwise, the petitioners have not been allotted the place of posting of their choice despite being higher in merit, which is contrary to the policy of the respondents in effecting transfers of even Guest Teachers hence, the respondents are under an obligation to reconsider their action of transferring the Guest Teachers from one place to another.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing representation dated 21.11.2022 (Annexures P/7 to P/9), which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be

satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representations.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representations dated 21.11.2022 (Annexures P/7 to P/9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in their representations dated 21.11.2022 (Annexures P/7 to P/9), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representations dated 21.11.2022 (Annexures P/7 to P/9) by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
