The petitioners through instant petition are seeking direction to official respondents to conduct free and fair investigation of the case arising from GD No.27 dated 11.11.2022 under Sections 307, 326, 148 and 149 of IPC in FIR No.94 dated 22.10.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that respondents are influential people, thus, police has registered FIR against petitioners whereas petitioners are aggrieved persons and have suffered grievous injuries. On various representations and visits, the police has registered GD No.27 dated 11.11.2022 under Sections 307, 326, 148 and 149 of IPC in FIR No.94 dated 22.02.2022, however, there is no further progress of the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures that jurisdictional authorities would look into the matter and do the needful.

This Court in view of the statement of learned State counsel is sanguine of the fact that competent authority would look into the matter and redress grievance of the petitioners. No further order is warranted.
