Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to release regular pension, gratuity, commuted value of pension and other retiral benefits.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 23.03.2021 (P-6) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s)-State and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

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In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-Secretary, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Punjab, to decide the aforesaid legal notice by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of 04 (four) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
