Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that implementation of transfer policy qua the Guest Teachers is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the petitioner was initially transferred in the month of November and now he is again dislodged, which is totally arbitrary and illegal. Further grievance of the petitioner is that even otherwise, the petitioner has not been given station of his choice despite being higher in merit, which is contrary to the policy of the respondents in effecting transfers of even Guest Teachers hence, the respondents are under an obligation to reconsider their action of transferring the Guest Faculty Teachers from one place to another.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing representation dated 03.12.2022 (Annexure P/13), which is still

pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 03.12.2022 (Annexure P/13) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation dated 03.12.2022 (Annexure P/13), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 03.12.2022 (Annexure P/13) by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
