Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is working as a Guest Lecturer in the subject of Management and the subjects being taught by the petitioner are being given to the other Guest Lecturers so as to contend that the workload for the Guest Lecturer in the said subject is less. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that once the subjects are being taught by the Guest Lecturer, who has been appointed in the subject of Management, giving those subjects to the other lecturers is totally arbitrary and illegal and contrary to the settled principle of law hence, the respondents be restrained from calculating the workload of the post of Guest Lecturer (Management) by giving the workload of subject of management to other Guest Lecturers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of

filing a representation dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P/10), which is still pending for consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P/10) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her representation dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P/10), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P/10) by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

It is made clear that till the decision on the representation of the petitioner is taken, no adverse action will be taken against the petitioner.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
