The petitioner herein has filed the instant writ petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to renew his arms licence bearing No.DN/SAS/DUP/MLNG/0616/53 valid upto 31.05.2019.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner herein would contend that vide application dated 27.05.2019, he had applied for renewal of his arms licence, which was valid upto 31.05.2019. However, as his licence was not being renewed, he had no option but to approach this Court.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued, an affidavit of the District Magistrate, SAS Nagar (Mohali) is made available on the record. As per the affidavit, on the recommendation made by the SSP, a decision to renew the arms licence of the petitioner was taken. The arms licence of the petitioner stands renewed upto 31.05.2022.

The affidavit of the District Magistrate has been perused as well as Annexure R-2/3 whereby the arms licence stand renewed from 01.06.2019 till 31.05.2022. Consequently, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

Since the main petition itself has been disposed of, the prayer in the application i.e. CM No.18879 of 2021 has become infructuous and disposed of as such.
