The petitioner herein is defendant No.2 in a suit for possession by way of specific performance of the various agreements to sell. His application for impounding the agreement to sell dated 25.03.2014 alleging that the document is not sufficiently stamped, has been dismissed. The Court found that the document is sufficiently stamped as there is no recital with regard to the delivery of possession.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
