KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case having FIR No. 610 dated 31.07.2022, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 120-B and 216 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Old Industrial, District Panipat.

The counsel for the petitioners at the outset wishes to withdraw the petition qua petitioner No.2 Neeraj.

In view of the above, instant petition stands dismissed as withdrawn in respect of petitioner No.2 Neeraj.

The counsel for the petitioner Joni Singh submits that only allegation against the said petitioner is that he gave fist blows and slaps to the complainant and that petitioner is in custody for the last more than 04 months and is having no criminal history and after completion of investigation the police has presented the challan and co-accused Nathi @

Amar is granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 07.12.2022 (Annexure P-2).

The present petition is opposed by the State counsel who on instructions from SI Inder Singh has not refuted the fact that only fist blows were attributed to the petitioner Joni Singh who is in custody for the last more than 04 months and is having no criminal history and further co-accused Nathi @ Amar has been given benefit of regular bail.

In the present case only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner who is incarcerated for the last more than 04 months. After completion of investigation the police has presented the challan but it will take considerable time for the trial to conclude even after its commencement. Co-accused Nathi @ Amar who also gave fist blows at the time of occurrence is already enlarged on bail.

For the foregoing reason this Court is of the view that no purpose would be served by prolonging the custody of the petitioner Joni Singh.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed qua petitioner Joni Singh @ Joni Rana and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
