CP Nos 1 and 2 of 2019 have been filed under Sections 454 (5) and 456 of the Companies Act, 1956, respectively, complaining non-filing of the statement of affairs and not handing over possession of the assets, properties, books of accounts and records of company in liquidation by the former directors. Despite repeated attempts the official liquidator has failed to serve the notice to the respondents. On 17.03.2022, this Court even directed the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram and Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to trace and serve the notice to the respondents. But despite all these efforts, respondents are still not served.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the matter is closed with liberty to revive the petitions, if the official liquidator is able to locate the address of the respondents.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
