In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that they have not been released the LTC for the block year 2016-2019 and their entitlement qua the said benefit is covered by the decision of this Court in CWP No. 18603 of 2020 titled as ***Sajjan Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 16.11.2022 hence, respondents are under obligation to grant the petitioners the benefit as being prayed for in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) , by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
