The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs. 45,88,266/- including security qua the works executed by the petitioner alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner was allotted various work during the year 2020 to 2022. The petitioner has completed some of the works and the remaining works are being executed. However, balance payment of Rs. 45,88,266/- including security has not been released to the petitioner.

It is contended that the bill with respect to the aforesaid work has already been sent to the respondent-authorities and various representations including representation dated 25.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) has been made by the petitioner to the respondent No.3-the Executive Officer, the Improvement Trust, Patiala for release of his due payment.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case the respondent No.3-the Executive Officer, the Improvement Trust, Patiala is directed to look into the representation dated 25.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2.

Mr. Saurav Verma, who is the Additional Advocate General Punjab and would thus be on the panel of all statutory Board and Corporations of the State of Punjab has been requested to accept notice on behalf of the respondents No.3 & 4.

On the asking of the Court, he accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.3 & 4 and has no objection in the event such prayer of the petitioner as aforesaid is accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with consent and without commenting on the merits of the claim, with a direction to respondent No.3-the Executive Officer, the Improvement Trust, Patiala to examine the grievance espoused by the petitioner in the representation dated 25.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order

thereupon within a period of 03 months of the receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

Needless to mention that in the event any amount is found payable, the same shall be released forthwith and preferably within a period of 03 months of such a decision being taken by the respondent-authorities.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
