1. This order shall decide COCP-4046-2019, COCP-1154 & 1940-2020 and COCP-308-2021 as prayer in all petitions is quackery, intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 10.10.2018, in CWP-19236-2013.

2. Learned AAG, Punjab on instructions from Shri Shashi Garg, Law Officer, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, states that although the petitioners are not party to CWP-19236-2013 decided on 10.10.2018, compliance of which is being sought, decision has been taken by the government to accord relief to all employees, who are similarly situated as the petitioners in CWP-19236-2013 and that necessary relief would be granted to the petitioners within six weeks from today. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioners, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the contempt petition.

3. In view of the position noted above and without commenting upon the maintainability of the instant petition, the same is disposed of as not calling for any action the against respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
