This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent No.7 to remove the illegal Electro Magnetic Radiation (EMR) Mobile Tower in the school and the authorities/respondents No.1 to 6 may also be directed to remove the illegal Mobile Tower forthwith; along with certain other prayers.
